- Tail end: purple and blue silks (violin and viola)
- Peg end: similar colors to Crystal and Alliance codes indicating the note and tension.















## 2. ANTI OXIDATION BAG

The individual strings will also come with this special packing (by 5 pieces).

The string keeps its freshness intact for an extended period.
